### Who will I be responsible for?

U16/U15 Boys' Age Group

### What is my role?

1. To realise the objectives agreed with the Junior Head Coach and Men's Head Coach.
2. Planning, monitoring and delivery through safe, effective and relevant coaching sessions to enable the advancement of skill and performance of individual squad members and the squad as a whole.
3. Responsibility for team selection and match management.
4. To act as a positive and professional role model, displaying good coaching conduct at all times promoting an enjoyable and inclusive atmosphere.
5. To abide by and promote EHB's Code of Ethics & Behaviour, Equality Policy and Safeguarding and Protecting Young People policies.

### What else can you tell me about the role?

1. Provide regular verbal feedback to players and verbal and written feedback to their parents
2. Liaison with Junior Head Coach, head of junior performance academy and Men's Head Coach with regards to nominations to local JDC

### Training needed

You should be able to demonstrate coaching experience (ideally at a level that equates to the old Level 2/new Sessional/EHB coaching qualifications). Experience and coaching style are more important than purely qualifications – although a proper understanding of the Player Pathway, Golden Thread and National Development Themes are desirable as part of the wider objectives of the Club in our continuing development of junior players. Should also have up to date first aid qualification and attended a Safeguarding and Protecting Children workshop (these can be arranged prior to taking up the role).

### How much time will I need to give to the role?

Around 3 hours a week (including preparation time) – of which two hours will be on Sunday mornings.
