

Aylesbury HC Document - Halton Restrictions

No spectators in pitch area

- a single parent / guardian is permitted for U18s & a 'chauffeur' for any non-drivers etc; no children, no families, no extended friends
- they are permitted to socially distance outside of the fenced pitch

No use of grandstands at all

No use of dugouts at all

AHC Keyholder must open-up & close afterwards - there can be no 'opening up' of the pitch/building by/for another club.

Toilets

- There are separate toilets for male/ female. Male toilets are on the left hand side corridor, female toilets are to the right hand side corridor.
- Occupancy in each has been reduced (sinks/toilets have been taken off-line) and occupancy level allowed is displayed on the doors. Only 2 people can go in toilets and 1 in the disabled.

Meet time no earlier than 30mins prior to push-back

Meet locations will be signposted on the grass the opposite side of the Nuffield Pavilion

Warm-up location on the grass the opposite side of the Nuffield Pavilion

Pitch entry

- Only for players, officials & coaches - nobody else
- Enter via the small gate
- Exit via the large double gate
- The large gate must be closed at all times other than when players are exiting

Sani Cloth wipes will be provided in the entrance to the Nuffield for clubs to wipe down equipment such as goals.

All rubbish needs to be placed in new bins provided.

Absolutely no nose-clearing, spitting or rinsing of mouth with water at the site (other than in toilets) - these will result in a participant banned from site.

Non-active participants (coaches & subs) shall socially distanced at all times

COVID19 Rules for Visitors/Contractors at RAF Halton

**RAF Halton are following Government Direction
All visitors/contractors entering site are agreeing to comply.
Those that do not will be escorted off site.**

**Only essential visitors/contractors
will be permitted access to RAF Halton.**

- Your Host/Point of Contact will brief you on any procedures for the building/s you are due to enter, for example if a one-way system is in operation.
- Use your own pen to sign any documentation required for your visit.
- Workmen/women are to ensure the site of work is left clean and tidy.
