

Newbury and Thatcham Hockey Club Visiting Teams Covid-19 Guidance

You must follow the England Hockey Guidance during the match. Outside of the match, government advice (particularly the 'rule of 6') should be followed.

Matches at Henwick Sports Ground

On arrival, please park in the car park as usual and walk down to the pitch in a socially distanced manner.

- Please arrive ready to play as currently no changing facilities are available
- Toilets are available in the clubhouse, please follow signposted procedures
- Please do not arrive excessively early to your meet time to avoid overcrowding
- Your temperature will be taken on entry to the pitch
- Maintain social distancing, and groups of 6 or less whilst waiting to enter the pitch
- Belongings should be placed, along the fence, **please do not use the dugouts**
- Substitutes and coaches must remain on the concrete at all times
- Warm-up balls must all be put away before the match starts
- Spectators must remain outside the fence, and follow social distancing
- Ensure you take all your belongings, and any rubbish with you after the match
- Exit via the back or side gate as instructed in line with the one-way system
- Cool downs and debriefs should be done outside of the pitch area to allow the next teams to enter the pitch
- Once the game has ended, please maintain social distancing & groups of less than 6

Teas will be provided for visiting teams playing at Henwick, please follow the procedures set out in the clubhouse, and provide your information for NHS Test and Trace.

Matches At Trinity School

- Please arrive ready to play as changing facilities may not be available
- Park in the car park, and wait on the LEFT HAND SIDE of the gate to the pitch
- As there is only one gate please let the previous teams exit the pitch before entering.
- Maintain social distancing, and groups of 6 or less whilst waiting to enter the pitch
- Toilets are available, following the procedures put in place by the school
- Your temperature will be taken on arrival to the pitch
- Belongings should be spread out along the fence, on the concrete
- Substitutes and coaches must remain on the concrete at all times.
- Warm-up balls must all be put away before the match starts
- Spectators must remain outside the fence and follow social distancing
- Ensure you take all your belongings, and any rubbish with you after the match
- Exit the pitch and turn LEFT away from the players waiting to enter
- Cool downs and debriefs should be done outside of the pitch area to allow the next teams to enter the pitch;
- Once the game has ended, please maintain social distancing & groups of less than 6
